John Stuart is Associate Dean for Cultural and Community Engagement in FIU's College of Communication, Architecture + The Arts, Executive Director of the Miami Beach Urban Studios and Director of the CARTA Innovation Lab for 3D-Printing. He is also a tenured full-professor in the Department of Architecture at FIU where he has taught for over two decades, serving as Founding Director of the Graduate Program and as Department Chair. He is a futurist, innovator, designer and artist involved in collaborative research projects with funding from Van Alen Institute, The National Endowment for the Arts, The National Science Foundation, The National Endowment for the Humanities, The Knight Foundation, and The Graham Foundation for Advanced Studies in the Fine Arts. Stuart has produced three book and has lectured and taught widely in the United States on technology, architecture, design, urbanism, innovation and identity, and is currently working on projects that point to new directions in interdisciplinary innovation and research that engage music, design, art and environmental sciences. Based on his work at the Urban Studios with the CARTA Innovation Lab for 3D printing, Prof. Stuart was invited to take part in the newly-formed HP/EDUCAUSE International Research Consortium that includes Brown, Yale, MIT, Stanford, Harvard, Cornell and about a dozen other institutions to explore Building the Campus of the Future: 3D Technologies in Academe.
